## Operating Systems

**System Upgrades** happen in the Summer, typically in August.

**Connections** Each smart podium is equipped with an installed HDMI cable to connect devices (PC laptops) to the projector. VGA cables are available in 102A, 205, and 230. If a different type of connection is required (Mac laptops, tablets, I-pads, iPhones, etc), the user must bring their own adapter to connect to the HDMI/VGA cable. An ethernet cable is installed for internet connectivity and an audio cable is installed along with the VGA cable (only in rooms with VGA) to provide sound from connected devices.

**All classrooms have the following equipment installed** Computer, keyboard, mouse DVD/Blu-Ray player, USB hub, Ceiling-mounted LCD projector, Microphone system (varies by room), Whiteboards and markers.
